

Art Go on an autumn walk and look for interesting things in the environment, what did you find? Can you collect them and make them into a picture?



Science

Why do we need to wash our hands? How do you wash your hands? We would like to encourage this skill in all of the children.

Maths

Point out numbers that are important to your child. Show your child how numbers are used on houses or buses. What number is their house? How old are they? What numbers are on a car number plate? Count how many steps, items, claps, jumps. Practise counting forward and backwards while doing fun activities and read number books together.

Literacy and PSHE

Encourage your child to hold and use pencils and pens whenever they show an interest. Can they draw their family? How many people are in their family? Can you help them label everyone?

Share stories about starting school and ask your child to share things that they have done during the day. Can they draw a new friend that they have made?

Phonics

Encourage your children to listen to the world around them. Get them to think about the things they hear in the environment, at home, at the park, near the road etc. Help your child to recognise the sounds around them.

RE

In RE we are learning about how much God loves us and our families. Please can you send a picture of you and your family into school so that we can share this in class.

Reading

Look for letters that are in your child's name in the environment. Can they see letters on food packages, bus stops or road signs? Look for the first letter of their name. You could even share the names of the different letters.

PE

Encourage your children to make big movements, like jumping, running, skipping, hopping, rolling etc. These will help develop your child's muscles, balance and co-ordination.

Reading

Share a story with your child, as much as possible read a book with your child every day.
