### Flu Vaccination Details - Reception to Y6 Pupils Only

The NHS immunisation will be attending schools to vaccinate students with the Seasonal Flu Vaccine starting from September 2024.

<https://www.sheffieldchildrensvaccinations.co.uk/Forms/Flu> to complete the consent form. The option to consent or decline the vaccination is at the end of the questionnaire so please complete this even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination.

The nasal flu vaccine contains products derived from pigs (porcine gelatine). To opt for the gelatine-free inactive injection, select 'NO' on the nasal spray option and you will be given further options to choose.

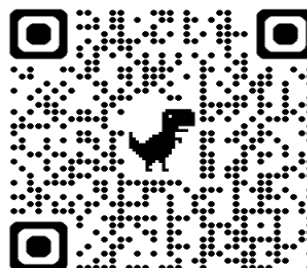
### Notice from Miss Sheeran – Online Safety
