### Online Safety Notice

#### [Be Kind Online](#)

As parents and educators, we all model how to be kind to each other, how to be present for our friends and how to conduct ourselves daily. However, it is just as important that we model and discuss how to do this online. It is easy to hide behind a group chat app or an online profile to pass on comments or images we would not ordinarily share in person. We need to help children understand the importance of being kind all the time, whether this is face to face or while messaging. Children can often get swept up into group mentality and agree with others comments or refusing to disagree which can lead to upset and arguments.

This week we have attached a poster to help you understand the risks and allow you to have these conversations with your children about how to act online and how to get help when necessary.
