Y6 Residential to Newby Wiske Hall October 2025

In October 2025, we will be taking our Year 6 children to PGL Newby Wiske Hall in North Yorkshire. Please feel free to view further details of the new centre using this link [Here](#).

The dates of the residential are Wednesday 22nd October until Friday 24th October 2025. As it is a residential, the overnight accommodation, food, activities and travel are included in the £225.00 per child cost.

We understand that £225.00 is a lot of money, but when you consider the range of activities and the transferable interpersonal and independence skills that the children come away with, we believe that the residential, ultimately, shows value for money.

We appreciate that in one lump sum, £225.00 is a large amount and in an effort to make the opportunity available to all pupils, school offers an instalment-based payment scheme. **A non-refundable deposit of £75.00 is required by Friday 28th March 2025** to secure your child's place. Please make your payment via ParentMail online payment system named PGL Newby Wiske Residential Y6 October 2025. We have allowed for payments in smaller instalments of £10.00 or more at a time to allow parents to pay the balance when they wish. However, please note that the amounts in the table below must be paid by the dates due.
