Cannon Hall Museum on Wednesday, 25th June 2025

As part of our History curriculum, we have arranged for the children in **St Joan of Arc class** to visit the Cannon Hall Museum on **Wednesday, 25th June 2025**, for a Victorian kitchen workshop. The details for this trip are as follows (please retain this section of the letter for information on the day):

The children will live the life of a Victorian servant for the day. They will sample the delights of a meal cooked on a Victorian range, and take part in typical servant's tasks as well as getting to see how wealthy people lived. So that the children feel completely immersed in the historical atmosphere we ask that children come dressed in Victorian clothing (ideas below):

Girls

- Mop cap
- Plain light blouse or shirt
- Plain dark long skirt
- Shawl (optional)
- White apron/pinafore
- Dark boots or shoes

Boys

- Boys Flat cap (not to be worn at the table)
- Light coloured plain shirt (collar can be tucked in or hidden by a thin scarf or a large colourful hanky tied round the neck)
- Long dark trousers
- Plain dark socks
- Black boots or shoes

Children will prepare soup, crumble and sugar mice - a real treat for all occasions, so do not need to bring a packed lunch. **If you child has food allergies please contact the school office for the ingredients.**

- This cost of the trip is **£20.00** and payment can be made through the ParentMail app.
- We will be travelling by coach and leaving school after morning registration at 9:15am. We will return to school for normal pick up time.
- If you are unable to provide a costume for your child they should wear school uniform **and sensible shoes suitable for walking**. They may also need **warm clothing / a light waterproof jacket** dependent on the weather. If it is sunny, please ensure you have applied **sun cream** before school and send your child with a **sun hat**, as well as a **water bottle**. They will need a **backpack/rucksack** to take their water bottle. (Please remember no fizzy pop or products containing nuts)

We will be asking for 2 parent/carer volunteers (which will be chosen by random selection). Please indicate below if you would like to volunteer.
