**Second Reading:** **A reading from the Letter of St Paul to the Colossians**

**1: 15-20**

*"All things were created through him and for him."*

Christ is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation, for by him all things were created in heaven and on earth were created, in heaven and on earth visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things

hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church; He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be pre-eminent. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

### **The Word of the Lord**

**Acclamation. Alleluia, Your words, O Lord are spirit and life; you have the words of eternal life. Alleluia.**

**GOSPEL: A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke 10: 25-37**  
***"Who is my neighbour?"***

At that time: A lawyer stood up to put Jesus to the test saying, "Teacher," "what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" He said to him, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?" And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind and your neighbour as yourself." And he said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this, and you will live."

But he, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbour?" Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho and fell among robbers, who stripped him, beat him, and departed, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a priest was going down that road, and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. So likewise, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan as he journeyed, came to where he was, and when he saw him, he had compassion. He went to him and bound up his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he set him on his own animal, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And the next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, saying, 'Take care of him, and whatever more you spend, I will repay you when I come back.' Which of these three, do you think, proved to be a neighbour to the man who fell among the robbers?" He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go and do likewise."
