First Reading: **A reading from the Book of Revelation 7: 2-4, 9-14.**

"I looked and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation,"

I John saw another angel ascending up from the rising of the sun, with the seal of the living God. And he called out with a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm earth and sea, saying: "Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees until we have sealed the servants of our God on the foreheads" And I heard the number of the sealed: 144,000 sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel. After this I looked, and behold a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all the tribes, and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. Clothed in white robes with palm branches in their hands. And crying out with a loud voice: "Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb." And all the angels were standing around the throne and round the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying: "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honour and power and might be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!" Then one of the elders addressed me, saying, who are these in clothed white robes, and from where have they come from?" I said to him, "Sir, you know. and he said to me, "These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
